



HOWARD JONES SET TO APPEAR AT TULALIP RESORT CASINO FRIDAY, JUNE 17

TICKETS FOR SINGLE SHOW IN ORCA BALLROOM ON SALE FRIDAY, APRIL 22

TULALIP, Wash. (February 22, 2022) – Attracting listening audiences and concertgoers with major hits for more than 30 years, Howard Jones brings his special brand of synthpop to the Orca Ballroom stage for a single show at Tulalip Resort Casino on Friday, June 17. Opening the show are special guests Midge Ure, former lead singer for New Wave band Ultravox, and synthpop/electronica artists All Hail the Silence.

As a leader of the “Second British Invasion” music movement, Jones has been called one of the defining figures of mid-1980s synth-pop. The Welsh musician, singer and songwriter scored 10 Top 40 hit singles in the U.K., including “What is Love,” “New Song” and “Things Can Only Get Better.” His hit single “No One is to Blame” reached #4 on the U.S. charts and four others ranked in the Top 20 in the U.S.

Midge Ure performed, produced and penned several hit singles of the 1980s, including Ultravox’s signature songs “Vienna” and “Dancing with Tears in My Eyes.” Known for the use of synthesizers in their performances, All Hail the Silence spotlights the collaboration of American electronic musician BT and English singer-songwriter Christian Burns.
