Jonny Lang & The Robert Cray Band is the newest addition to Tulalip Resort's Summer Concert Series lineup

They have recorded 20 studio releases, 15 of which have been on the Billboard charts, including "Smoking Gun" and "Don't Be Afraid Of The Dark." They have played bars, concert halls, festivals and arenas around the world.
